

Winter Watering Guidelines

Water two (2) times a month when the temperature is above 40 degrees and there is no snow on the ground. Please water in the morning. Use a hose or bucket and disconnect the hose from your spigot after watering (Do not turn your irrigation system on). Generally a slow deep watering is the best way to go.

General Guidelines for how much water:

Deciduous Trees: Apply 10 gallons of water for each inch in diameter of the tree trunk.

Evergreen Trees: Apply 5 gallons of water for every three feet of tree height.

Shrubs and grasses
